

Jesus Christ: Our King

Hebrews 1:1-14

As stated before, in this series, the first chapter in Hebrews reveals Christ to us as prophet, priest and king (vs. 1-3). As chapter one continues to reveal that Christ is better than the angels (vs. 4), we get a larger view of Christ as King (personally and universally). He is worshipped by the angels (vs. 6). He is equal with God and has an enduring throne (vs. 8-9 cp. Psalm 45:6-7; John 1:1-3,14). Christ created the universe. He is eternal and shall endure forever, beyond the life of the universe, as we know it (vs. 10-12 cp. Psalm 102:25-27).

As prophet - He proclaims the will of God to us.

As priest - He purchased us and perfects us.

As king - He takes possession of us. He rules and protects us.

Christ our King:

Confronts us with His Truth.

II Corinthians 10:3-5

Captures us from His (and our) Enemy.

Colossians 1:13; Ephesians 2:1-6

Conforms us to His Will.

Romans 5:21

He brings a new law to us (Romans 8:1-4).

He enforces that Law (Psalm 89:27-36; Revelation 3:19).

Have we heard our prophet?

Have we received our priest?

Are we following our King?
