

A Look at the Kingdoms to Come

Daniel 2:24-25

See the special supplemental page entitled, "Six Kingdoms Revealed in the Book of Daniel." When men look at the World's kingdoms (chapter 2 – Nebuchadnezzar's dream) they see precious metal / valuable mineral. When God sees this world's kingdoms (chapter 7 – Daniel's vision from God) He sees beasts / animals. See Psalm 49 (esp. vs. 12, 20); Psalm 9:16-20; 46:6-11; Isaiah 40:12-24 (esp. vs. 15, 22-23).

Consider Matthew 4:8-10. What did Jesus see when he beheld the kingdoms of this world?
See also Psalm 2:1-9; Revelation 11:15; 19:11-16.

Note: Christ's Future Kingdom: The stone (Daniel 2:34) strikes at the feet (not legs) of the image which represents the kingdoms of this world. Christ's earthly kingdom will be established in the future, after the Kingdom of Anti-Christ, not during the Roman Empire and the times of the Apostles / Church-Age.

See Daniel 2:34-35, 44-45 cp. Matthew 21:42-46. What stone is Jesus talking about? What difference is there between falling on the stone and the stone falling on someone?
